4	<b><u>Zimmerman Community Club Scholarship</u></b>	The applicant will be chosen based on having a parent that served or is serving in the Military. They will also look at academic achievement, extracurricular/community involvement, and the quality of the essay written on the Zimmerman High School Scholarship Application.	1/\$500
