

## Free or Low Cost Immunization Clinics Elk River Area Schools

### No Shots, No School Immunization Initiative

This initiative collaborates with school districts and community partners in health, and public health to have all children immunized. This program is available August and the first two weeks of September. Parents are encouraged to schedule appointments with a primary care doctor early to ensure required immunizations are given and documented well in advance of starting school. - ✓ Download form to bring to clinic <http://www.parknicollet.com/~media/Files/pdf/Foundation/18336-Barrier-FreeImmunizations.pdf>
- ✓ Bring a copy of your child's immunization record.
- ✓ If you have insurance, bring your insurance card to the clinic. If your insurance does not cover immunizations, tell clinic staff.
- ✓ If your child has health insurance or is enrolled in a Medical Assistance program, your insurance will be billed.
- ✓ You will not be charged if your child does not have health insurance or your child's insurance does not cover immunizations.
- ✓ Bring the forms back to school to show that your child has now received the required immunizations.
