Safety Procedures	Blue Notes	In order to better support effective communication, we are requesting that parents send a note with their child to request a <i>blue note</i> for parent pick up from school. <u>A blue note is only required for 6th and 7th grade students if they are leaving early for the day.</u> If a change occurs during the school day and a parent must call the school, please contact the office by 2 PM. (If your 1st-5th grade child exits the main entrance daily, please see the office for an everyday dismissal form to receive a bag tag.)

	Pick Up/ Drop Off	<p>We are requesting that all parents observe the following expectations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Put student and staff safety first when driving on or near school grounds. ▪ Drive vehicles to the farthest open slot around the circle to allow more parents to pick up/drop off their children. ▪ Pick up and drop off students within the designated area only. ▪ Be aware of students and staff members who are in the crosswalk areas at all times. ▪ Do not drive through the crosswalk area when students/parents/staff are crossing. ▪ Park in the lot if entering the building. (Do not park in the pick up/drop off area.) <p>We discourage parents from walking into the building to pick up their children at the end of the day; however, students must have an adult walk with them from the building to the parking lot.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Observe all posted traffic signs and traffic laws.
	Visitors	<p>Visitors are welcome! During the school day, all visitors entering the school will only be able to do so through the main entrance via a secured video intercom system. If the main door is locked, please use the intercom system to request access to the building.</p> <p>All visitors must sign-in at the main office and secure a sticker, which must be worn while in the building. Please remember to sign out when leaving the building.</p>
	Drills	<p>We will conduct the following safety drills during the school year:</p> <p><u>Fire</u> (5 drills- The first drill is announced and occurs during the first week of school.)</p> <p><u>Lock-down</u> (5 drills- The first drill is announced and occurs during the first week of school.)</p> <p><u>Severe Weather</u> (1 drill- in the spring)</p> <p><u>Bus</u> (2 drills- one in the fall and one in the spring)</p>
