Please keep in mind that, per your Student Agreement, AVID is not a casual class that can be dropped without a conference with the AVID counselor, AVID teacher, AVID parent, and AVID student. This is due to a large financial and time commitment that has been made to you as an AVID student. However, if you would still like to begin the process of exiting from AVID, please complete the following process and turn all paperwork into the AVID coordinator at your school.

Exiting AVID is a three part process.

1. The AVID student will complete this form
2. Student will attach a one page typed essay to this form addressing desire to exit AVID.
3. Student will participate in an AVID exit interview with the AVID counselor. Interviews will be scheduled before and after school only - per availability of the AVID council members.
