

How to Submit Your Scholarship Application Using Google Forms

- Go to the **RHS website** and then click on the **Counseling tab** → **Financial Aid & Scholarships**
- Select [2022 General RHS Scholarship Application](#)
- Sign into Google to complete application (if it did not open automatically)

The general application is formatted as a Google Form. It would be best to have your information and essay(s) ready to submit when you begin the application, although you will be able to edit your application until the deadline date on 3/11/22 @ 12pm.

General Application Essay Instructions:

For the General Application, write an essay about ONE of the three following topics:

1. *What do you hope to do in the future with your degree, and why have you chosen this specific field of study?*
2. *What would you consider to be the best advice you have received? Share how it has impacted you.*
3. *How would receiving a scholarship impact your post secondary goals? Please explain your financial need.*

Create a Google Doc for your general essay and title the document (**Lastname, Firstname - General Scholarship Essay**), as well as any additional essays. You will be uploading these essays separately into the Google Form.

You will receive a confirmation email when your application has been submitted.

Other Local Scholarships:

Several scholarships have a separate application or instructions (as noted under [Application Information](#)). Those scholarships each have a link to a separate application, and some will need to be printed off, filled out and sent directly to the donors. Please follow the instructions carefully to ensure that your applications are submitted completely and correctly.

Scholarship Tips:

Scholarships are gifts. Someone has either raised or earned money to help students pay for college expenses. Your application needs to reflect the hard work someone else has put in for your benefit.

Scholarships are competitions. Each donor is looking for something specific, but are all looking for the best candidate. Your application will be compared to other students, so this is the time to brag about yourself! Let people know about all the interesting and exciting things you're doing in and out of school. The more completely you present yourself, the better your chances are of earning a scholarship.

Scholarships are limited. Not everyone who applies for scholarships gets one. We wish that everyone who applied could win a scholarship, but there just isn't enough money to do that. That's why your application has to show you at your best.
