# Registration Presentation:

## **Important things to know BEFORE you register for classes**

- How many credits have you earned? How many do you need to graduate?
- What is your current junior schedule (1st & 2nd semester)?
- What classes are you required to take as a senior?
- What options do you have for classes (Blended, AP, Concurrent Enrollment, PSEO, Online, etc...)?
- What are the requirements for a 2 year college? A 4 year college?

**You will find resources to answer all of these questions in this presentation.**

# Credits:

1. Log into Campus and find your transcript. How many credits have you earned? (Typically, juniors can have a max of 24/24)
2. Look at your current junior schedule. Is your 2nd semester schedule accurate?
3. Determine what credits you still need in order to graduate.
  - a. [High School Graduation Requirements](#)
4. What credits are REQUIRED for seniors?
  - a. English (2 credits)
  - b. Social (2 credits): Economics and Government
  - c. Any other required classes you haven't taken or you have failed

# Required classes for seniors

- \*AP English Lit/Comp 12
- Online English 12

## SOCIAL

Choose **one** *Economics* course and **one** *Government* course

- Economics
- Blended Economics
- Online Economics
- \*AP Macroeconomics

### **AND**

- Government
- Online Government
- Blended Government
- \*AP Government

# What could my day look like at RHS?

- Full Time = RHS student taking all classes at RHS
- [Blended](#) = Classes meet in person 2-3 days a week at RHS
- [ISD728 online](#) = Classes are fully online taught by ISD staff
- [College credit options](#)
  - Concurrent Enrollment = College classes taught by RHS staff on RHS campus
  - Advanced Placement = College level courses taught by RHS staff on RHS campus (final exam score and prospective college determines whether college credit is awarded)
  - [PSEO](#) = College courses taught by college professors on the college campus
    - Grades earned in PSEO are NOT weighted and follow the A, B, C, D, F grading scale (no plus or minus grades)
- Any combination of the above!

# What if I want to take PSEO classes?

- **Register for RHS courses as if you will still be a full time RHS student for your senior year**
1. Set up an appointment with Ms. Bartus sometime in February to complete the application process and discuss graduation requirements:
    - a. <https://bartuscounselor.youcanbook.me>
  2. Determine if you meet the college's eligibility requirements and choose your college
  3. Ms. Bartus will adjust your high school schedule once you have been accepted to the college and have chosen your college classes.

\*\*\*Grades earned in PSEO are NOT weighted and follow the A, B, C, D, F grading scale

(no plus or minus grades)

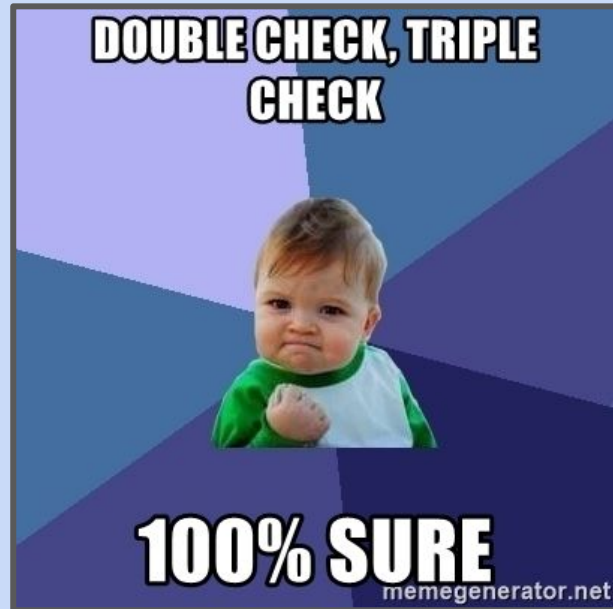


# College Preparation Resources:

- Two Year Colleges in MN
  - High School Diploma
  - GPA not considered
  - Accuplacer test for course placement
- Four Year State Universities in MN (excluding U of MN)
  - High School Diploma
  - Class Rank & GPA considered (top ½ of class)
  - ACT or SAT: Some schools will waive the test requirement, but it may still help if you take it
- U of MN
  - High School diploma with rigorous high school curriculum
  - Typically require 2 years foreign language, 4 years of math & 4 years of science
- Private Colleges in MN
  - Varies, check with individual college
- Outstate Opportunities

Double and Triple check your transcript AND your current schedule to make sure you are meeting the graduation requirements!

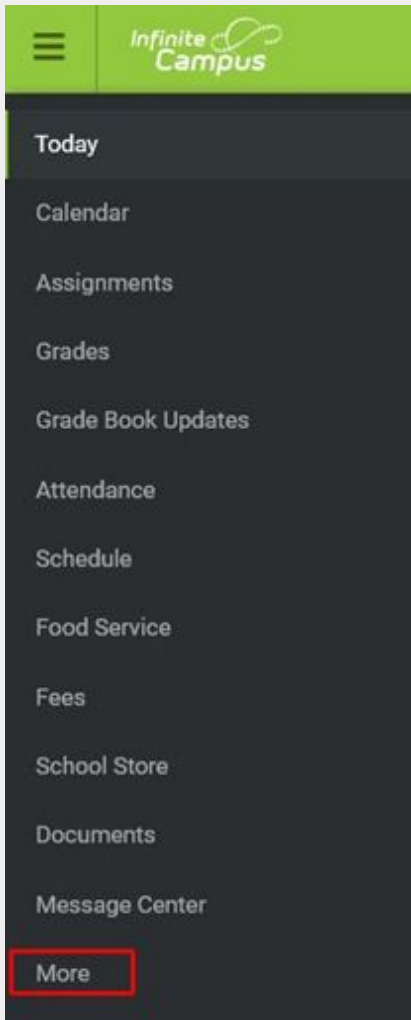

Log into your [Campus Portal](#) to begin registration for the 2021-2022 school year.

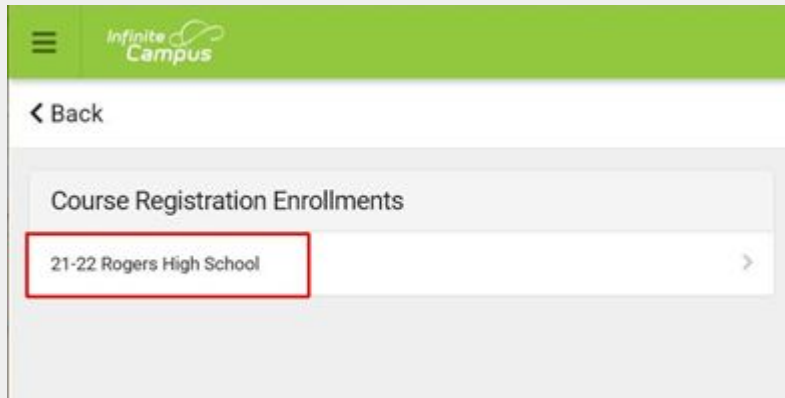


When you log in,

and then select **More**.

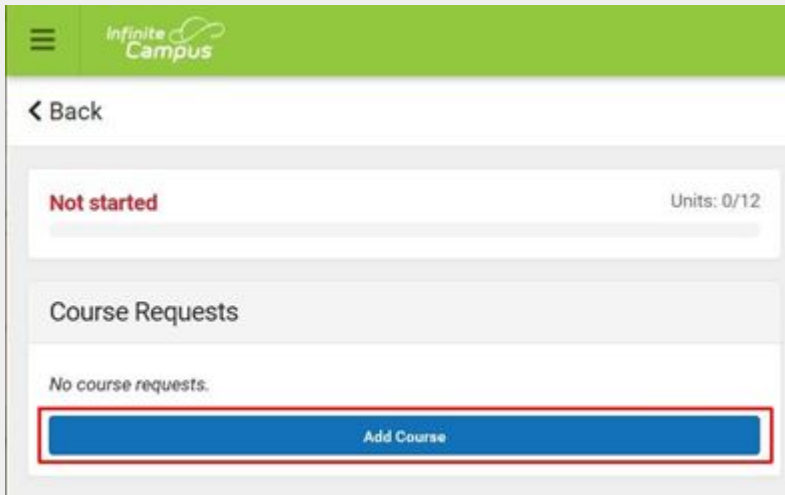


Select **Course Registration.**
